

BAWA BOARD MEETING 5/14/2020

In attendance: Tabitha Coleman, Mike Leister, Ted Detwiler, Michael Montanye, Kelly Heimbach, Tracey Hager, Janine Davidheiser, John Cooley, Bridgette Wise, Stacey Miller and Josh Heimbach.

Tracey called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m.

The minutes from last meeting were submitted. Ted motioned to approve minutes. Stacey second.

Dates: June 8th virtual BAWA meeting. Chair members only. The Grizzly duals, Arsenal Summer camp, Spring Arsenal and the Banquet have all been cancelled.

Treasurer's Report: Mike reviewed financials as forecast vs actual. The financials show a loss of approximately \$20,000 due to the cancellations from the pandemic. \$3000 was refunded for Arsenal camp. Spring arsenal will be transferred to Fall arsenal. \$1920 will be refunded for the banquet. Email will follow. \$500 will be paid to Sam Patchelor at the High school for a volunteer coach. Brian Campbell was paid \$500 for a volunteer coach at East and Russ Stankina will be paid \$500 as a volunteer coach at West. Mike will continue to plan the golf outing along with Josh Heimbach and John Cooley.

Tracey Hager – The Slabonik family has donated a \$1000 scholarship. BAWA voted and all were in favor of splitting it into two years. BAWA wanted to honor the family at next year's banquet for the scholarship. Two wrestlers submitted for the BAWA scholarship. Samantha Reitnour received the BAWA scholarship and Evan Mortimer received the Slabonik scholarship. Jim S. has graciously offered to pay for the High School and Middle School awards. Tracey will investigate any refund or extension of lease due to non-usage from the pandemic. Tracey will be in touch with Mark Fluharty to request a refund on the insurance as well. The wrestling gifts will be handed out later. BAWA will not compensate volunteer coaches for tournaments outside school wrestling events ex. PJW. Josh Heimbach has agreed to chair the tournament director position for BAWA pending Board approval. The Board will be voting on Josh Heimbach, Kelly Heimbach, Bridgette Wise and Craig Sigler at the June meeting.
